VI. Grading criteria (評分標準)

- 1) This class is pass or fail. No numerical or letter grade is awarded to students.
- 2) Students are expected to attend class regularly and participate. Absence from three or more classes (6 hours) without proper excuse may result in a loss of credit. Proper excuses include health reasons (doctor's note required) and other academic commitments.
- 3) Students will do a presentation on the final day of the course on a topic that will be decided on prior to the presentation.
- 4) Students will complete a self-assessment on the first and last day of the course.

VII. Course requirements (課程要求)

- 1) Students are expected to attend class regularly and be on time to the best of their ability.
- 2) Phone use is permitted for academic purposes. Phone calls should be taken outside of the classroom.
- 3) Students are expected to participate and prepare for class discussions as directed by the instructor.
- 4) The consumption of food and beverage in the classroom shall follow the rules and guidelines of the university and should not cause a distraction in the class.
- 5) All other university guidelines regarding student conduct should be adhered to.

1. All of the sessions will be **video recorded** for a further analysis as well as for students' self-assessment of their progress during the activities after obtaining students' and the instructor's consent.
2. The course schedule is subject to change in accordance with the instructor's and the students' specific topics of interest.
3. A questionnaire will be provided at the end of the program to understand students' perspectives on the program and the results will be for the future reference of the International Affairs Office.
