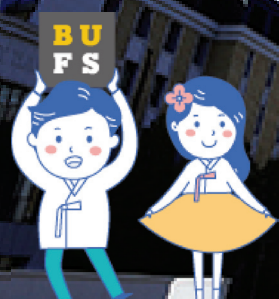


# BUFS Korean Language Short-Term Program Guide



Located in Busan, Republic of Korea, Busan University of Foreign Studies boasts state-of-the-art facilities for foreign language education. #### LEVEL-BASED LEARNING SUPPORT

All students enrolled in the short-term program will undergo a class placement test(level test) to determine their proficiency level in Korean. Based on the results, each student will be placed to appropriate levels such as beginner 1, 2, 3, intermediate 1, 2, 3, advanced 1, 2, etc.
